Little PAL Division Official Rules

1. The tournament has two divisions—boat and bank—each division has four categories: bass, crappie, catfish, and perch—with an open category this year which will include carp and drum. Prizes will be awarded to the anglers in each category.
2. The top three largest bass, carp, crappie, catfish, drum, and perch for each day will be the daily winners. Prizes will be awarded at 11:30 a.m. each tournament day. No angler may win more than one place. *(For example: If an angler has the 2nd largest catfish and the 3rd largest perch, they will be awarded the 2nd place prize in the catfish category.)* Also, anglers may only win 1st place once in a category. They may win any place other than 1st in a different category. This will allow another angler to move up in this category giving more young anglers an opportunity to win prizes.
3. Participants must be accompanied by a parent or adult. A written parental permission form must be signed by parent and turned in at registration. Participants must be 12 years of age or younger at the time of the tournament to compete and win prizes.
4. Fish must be caught on Lake Conroe between 8 a.m. and 11 a.m. of the official tournament day. Official weigh-in time is 8 a.m. until 11 a.m.
5. Youth anglers may fish with live bait or artificial lures. Fish must be weighed in by the contestant who originally caught the fish. Live bait will be furnished.
6. Contestant must be accompanied by parent or guardian at the time of weigh in.
7. All fish weighed in must be of legal length and delivered to the official weigh-in station using the furnished weigh-in bag.
8. Tournament officials have the right to refuse any entry.
